

ILLINOIS FUTURITY QUESTIONS

1. Who is eligible for the Illinois Morgan Horse Breeders Futurity?

Anyone can nominate their weanlings, yearlings, 2 year olds, or 3 year olds as long as all back nominations are met.

2. Where are these horses shown?

All classes are held in conjunction with the Illinois State Fair.

3. What are the classes available?

Weanling Championship...Yearling Championship...2 year old Pleasure Driving...3 & 4 year old Pleasure Driving
2 & 3 year old Park Harness... 3 & 4 year old English Pleasure... Alumni In Hand... Alumni Pleasure Driving
Alumni English Pleasure

4. What is the Alumni Division?

The Alumni Division is for any horse that has shown in the Illinois Futurity in the past, or for a one time back nomination fee of \$25.00, any horse that has not shown in the Illinois Futurity in the past.

5. Where does the money for premiums come from?

The State of Illinois gives us \$1000.00 towards the futurity. The rest of the money comes from nominations (or entry fees) made by August 1st. All monies go into the payback pool except \$500.00 for the next years Futurity to be used for trophies and other expenses.

6. What kind of payback is there?

- 1st place is 25% of the payback pool
- 2nd place is 20% of the payback pool
- 3rd place is 15% of the payback pool
- 4th place is 10% of the payback pool
- 5th place is 10% of the payback pool
- 6th place is 10% of the payback pool
- 7th place is 5% of the payback pool
- 8th place is 5% of the payback pool

In addition from the Stallion and Mare nominations \$35.00 goes to the winning weanling and yearling Sire and Dam (whoever nominated them) \$25.00 goes to the reserve winning weanling and yearling Sire and Dam (whoever nominated them)

6. Can I back nominate my colts?

Yes, there is a \$10.00 per horse per Division
