The Fourth Annual MVMHC Horse Show, held this year in St. Charles, Missouri at the St. Charles County Fairgrounds came off very smoothly with one hundred eighty entries competing for honors throughout the various classes. Among these there were approximately sixty Morgans, the remaining others being Equitation mounts. 'We would like to thank our show officials for a job well done. Among these were our very well known announcer, Mr. 'Walter Botkin, our capable ringmaster, Mr. R. J. Meyer, and Of course, Mr. N. K. Carnes of St. Paul, Minnesota who did such a fine job in judging this year's show. We thank you all, and our horse show committee who made it all possible.

The show got underway at nine-thirty Saturday morning, June 29, 1963, and after all was said and done, it was Funquest Falcon, owned by Stuart G. Hazard and shown by Mr. and Mrs. Neal Werts who emerged the victor as winner of the title of Grand Champion Stallion. In receiving this honor Falcon gained the first leg of the C. J. O'Neill Memorial Traveling Trophy which must be won three years in succession for permanent possession. The Reserve Champion award went to the ever popular, Mr. Breezy Cobra for owner Lewis Pape.

On the distaff side it was Belafina who reigned "Queen of All" as Grand Champion Mare for Mr. and Mrs. L. S. Greenwalt; and a truly regal lady she is. Receiving reserve honors were Bill Bartley and his "very" Pleasant Lady, who also went on to become the High Point Morgan Show Horse. It was a tired, but happy and maybe just a little dazzled, Bill Bartley who went home from the show that night.

For the first time we awarded a High Point Morgan Pleasure Horse Trophy this year and it was presented to Mr. Charles Rafferty of, Rockford, Ill, and his King Kookie, a black son of the crowd pleasing Cinnamon King.

The Main event and final class of the evening was the Morgan Saddle Stake. Here Judge Carnes liked what he saw in the flashy, hold going mare, Pleasant Lady and awarded her top money. She is owned and shown by Bill Bartley of Florissant, Mo, who also rode her to win the blue in the Morgan Saddle Class, 15 hands and over. Next came Funquest Falcon, an outstanding son of the Brown Falcon, who is owned by Stuart C. Hazard of Topeka Kansas and expertly ridden by Mrs. Neal Werts. Third tie went to Mr. Breezy Cobra owned and ridden by Lewis Pape, with fourth going to Mr. and Mrs. Paul Capelle's Congo's Pride and fifth to Emerald's Skychief from Emerald Acres Morgan Horse Farm.

As an added attraction in our show, this year we presented a demonstration of the Morgan as a cutting horse, with an exhibition by the registered Morgan stallion, Mr. Sandman, owned by Pendleton Farms, Bellerive, Ill., and shown by manager-trainer, Mr. Marlin Manning. A tyy little chestnut, he really showed us that when trained for his particular job, the Morgan truly has cow sense. Just another example of the versatility of the Morgan breed of horse.

The exhibitor entering the largest number of Morgans at the show was Dr. D. F. McCarthy of Florissant, Mo., All of his horses were shown by the capable Miss Larry Ann Moran a very busy young lady showing in fourteen classes and receiving eleven ribbons.
